



Research and Innovation Horizon 2020, under grant agreement 823867

- Broadening the understanding of ILO concept –
 Integrating Industry and Institutes in a tighter collaboration
- A vast amount of knowledge has been produced in the collaboration between ESS and its In-Kind Partners
- ESS is multidisciplinary in its nature offering opportunities for broad talent acquisition
- We are nearing the peak of capacity building In-Kind and spill over effects
- This generated Know-How is currently trapped in a bubble or self-contained ecosystem
