



Science policy at FEDERAL level (1)

- □ Space research (184 mio euro in 2014)
 □ Federal Scientific Institutions (124 mio euro)
 □ "Nuclear power cycle"
 □ Research programs of federal importance (with approval of the regions)
 □ Optional (with approval of the regions):
 - specific topics of common importance for the regions
 - actions in the scope of research data

Budget 2014: 616 mio euro; further transfer of activities in the future

Science policy at FEDERAL level (2)

- ☐ Partnerships of Belgium in international organisations and/or infrastructures: general rule:
 - Regions = investments
 - Federal: partnership fees;
- ☐ BUT MYRRHA = federal authority; which includes that the federal government is allowed to invest in this initiative.





Science policy at FEDERAL level (3)

→ + Fiscal measures for R&D: up to 80% tax reduction on jobs in research (financial impact: approx. 810 mio € in 2016)
